Autocross:

- Tim stated that Forest Grove Lumber is currently owned by 2 banks who are in a tug of war over the property. There is no lease info or contact info available.

Hill Climb:

- Bible Creek: Ripley stated that Charles is on vacation and will report at the next meeting.
 - Ripley stated that the event went well. We did have some timing issues with the equipment and ended up hard-wiring everything rather than using the TLink Wireless system. The issue looks to have been shorts and corrosion in our wiring between the sensors and TLink wireless system.
 - Ripley has purchased materials and tools to redo the ends of our existing cables and to create new cables to solve the problems. New cables have been built and tested and old cables have been repaired and tested. Timing for Maryhill Hillclimb should work fine.
