Introduction to Autocross + AX #1

Please join us for our annual **Charles Cope Memorial** Novice School - Introduction to Autocross.

This is a Driver Skills Clinic with individualized instruction.

This is a limited entry event for up to 25 students.

To help maximize participation, this event will fundamentally be run as a typical Autocross event. The main difference is that the very first run group of the day will be Students Only, and each student will be paired with a dedicated instructor. The instructor will greet their student when they arrive, walk them through the registration and vehicle tech inspection process, provide individualized course walks and answer any questions regarding WMC, autocross, and the event. The primary emphasis of the student/instructor session is to provide hands-on competitive driving experience in a safe, closed-course environment.

Students will learn all aspects of autocross, including how to be a corner worker when others are driving. Students will be able to practice various autocross features that will challenge the limits of their vehicles.

PRE REGISTRATION REQUIRED. NO WALK-UPS. Cost is only \$50 per student, or \$70 if you become a WMC Member. WMC membership provides savings at all upcoming WMC events.

Sign-in and Vehicle Tech Inspection is open between 7:30AM to 8:30AM. We recommend you arrive as close to 7:30AM as possible, as this is the first event of the season and delays can happen. Drivers meeting and chalk talk at 8:45. Event will happen rain or shine.

Loaner helmets are available at no additional cost. If you own or have access to a legal helmet, please bring it. All drivers over 18 will be required to sign up and be available to work the afternoon course. Drivers 16 & 17 must be accompanied at sign-in by parent or legal guardian.

Notarized permission slips are acceptable. Waiver form signature required.

After the first run group, the rest of the day will run like a normal autocross event with run-groups based on vehicle classes. The Student-Instructor Training will complete around Noon. Students can stay for the afternoon session and ride-alongs with their instructors or head home for the day. The afternoon session will operate 100% as a normal autocross event.
